


Port Transfers

• Port Transfers with Accommodation in Kissimmee and Lake Buena Vista you need to enter the Resort in first then "Airport" will be Cape Canaveral.




Boarding Time for Cruise

If cruising after arriving on a domestic flight, please allow at least 4 clear hours to arrive at the Port before departure and make customers aware there may be a delay

[Example: If cruise departs at 4 pm customers must be a Cruise Port at 12 pm]

They should be at the Port 4 hours before Cruise departs on any given Cruise Line at any given Port



Disembarkation for a Cruise

The disembarkation process can take anything from 1-4 hours depending on cruise line and nationality.

Therefore, please make sure if you are booking a Flight on the same day you are allowing at least 5clear hours from Cruise docking time before checking in for flight

[Example: Cruise docks at 7 am Flight must be no earlier than 2 pm]

Top Tip: Recommend to a client that they pre-book early boarding and disembarkation directly with the cruise line to save them time.

Drinks Packages

Always give a client that wants a Drinks Package the relevant cruise line website with the cruise confirmation number to add these on directly themselves

If a Cruise line has a offer whereby, they receive a **FREE beverage package** this is IMPERATIVE you check the details of this before booking.

Details can either be obtained by asking the Destinations Team, Sales Management or the quickest way would be checking on the cruise lines website.

In some instances, Amadeus may show a **FREE drinks package**, but this may only be Non-Alcoholic, in which case you may have mis-sold it.

Cabins

Wherever possible do try and up sell the Customer a slightly higher category of Cabin as not every customer would want the cheapest cabin available.

Check the bed configuration (Not Bunk Beds & not the Disabled cabin) again if unsure please check with Sale Manager.

ALWAYS give the customer the **Cabin number** at the **time of Booking** and the confirmation so they can check the deck plan themselves.

Gratuities

Gratuities should always be Included IF they are not this needs to be written on the customers notes on Go2Book and authorised by Sales Management **AGREED NO GRATUITIES ADDED**

Passports

You must ensure you are obtaining the correct nationality for each passenger for the Cruise Liner as this can affect things like gratuities, disembarkation etc.



Disney Cruises

Please ensure you are always comparing a Disney Cruise on their website to Amadeus.

When you are in the process of confirming the reservation, you will notice that payment details ask you to provide a credit card. To ensure that we can place this cabin on a deposit, please HOLD ON OPTION and notify accounts and load team immediately once you have the reference number, this way we can ensure that payment is dent directly to the cruise line straight away.

Royal Caribbean

Royal Caribbean will hold on an option before you add payment. Hold the cruise on option and it will say ONF. Then go back in to the reservation, add payment and select BK in the first yellow box and agency check in the second box, put in Ocean Holidays and your name in the next two yellow box options, confirm then go back and put in the ref to check that the reservation says CNF in the top right hand corner.

If you do not do this, the reservation will auto cancel.

Norwegian Cruises

Important info to remember:

You MUST add VAT onto the costings of the NET price as this will not show when making the Booking – please ask a member of Sales Management if you are unsure

If there is no Offer and one person in the cabin wants a drinks package, they all have to have the drinks package

They recommend booking the Wifi prior to departure as this always works out cheaper.

They can do this when they log onto the website at the same time as booking Excursions, Gratuities etc


But:

They have lots of OFFERS included and there is strict rules on these EXTRA's

Beverage packages – will be for the first two travellers within the cabin and includes the ULTIMATE Drinks package (on this occasion the other two don't have to have one) but depending on the OFFER at the time it doesn't always include inside cabins so always check

If you select the **Free Dining** selection – This includes **some** of the speciality restaurants Kids menu is still free in the speciality restaurant (if the cabin was based on 2 ad and 2ch) But if the kids wanted to eat of the main menu there would be a surcharge

On board credit can be another item included, the amount would depend on what cabin you have selected, for a Suite is \$100 for mini suite \$200 (you need to ring Norwegian and let them know the category for them to clarify if its included)



Wifi included – would be 250 hours per cabin

Before booking a Norwegian Cruise please make sure you check all Offers with Norwegian direct on: 02088349019

Transfers

IF they have TRANSFERS back to the Airport, they MUST be made aware that they will be at the airport by LUNCH and most flights won't be departing until EVENING.

Please ensure that you have added notes in to Go2Book to ensure that this has been done.

Remember, if they are cruising back into Tampa, there is plenty to do in the downtown area, as well as the Aquarium that they can visit before heading back to the airport as something good to do.

Port collection/return procedures:

Miami – For all Miami port bookings you will need to book the airport and Alamo then provide a free shuttle bus which operates every 15 minutes when the cruise liners dock.


Fort Lauderdale – Same procedure as above

Port Canaveral – All clients arriving off a cruise will take the Alamo courtesy bus to their local office. If clients are booking this as part of a one-way (i.e. MCO – Port Canaveral) clients will leave the vehicle at the Port Canaveral office and then take the free shuttle service to the port.

Tampa – The office that is closest to the port is Tampa Westin Downtown. Now this office does not provide a shuttle service so clients will have to make their own way to the office in a cab. This is the same procedure for clients wishing to return their vehicle to Tampa. There is no shuttle service from Tampa Airport.

THINGS TO KNOW

- You can hold the Cabins prior to taking Payment on Royal Caribbean and Carnival
- You will always need to take an Extra Deposit just for the Cruise normally £150.00pp at the time of Booking
- Only book the Cruise once you have confirmed and taken payment
- Then always give the customer the booking reference to log onto "Manage My Cruise"
- They recommend booking drinks packages, excursions, gratuities and Wifi prior to boarding
- When booking on Royal Caribbean & Norwegian websites Gratuities are normally always included but Carnival you do have to manually add if you want to include it
- Norwegian you do need to add VAT to the price which works out approximately 17% if booked on either Amadeus or their website



RCL Infant Policy



INFANT POLICY

Infants sailing on a cruise must be at least 6 months old as of the first day of the cruise and/or Cruise Tour. HOWEVER: For transatlantic, transpacific, Hawaii, select South American and other selected cruises and/or Cruise Tours, the infant must be at least 12 months old as of the first day of the cruise/Cruise Tour. For the purposes of this policy, any cruise that has 3 or more days consecutive at sea will require infants to be 12 months old on the first day of the cruise/Cruise Tour.

Infants can sail on our ships but they cannot access the pool if they are in nappies (water nappies are not allowed).

Carnival Infant Policy Carn



- Infant must be at least 6 months of age at time of sailing (on trans ocean/ remote itineraries it is 12 months)
- Carnival does not allow children in nappies or who are not toilet trained (this is line with the US department of Health

Minimum Ages for Travel

Please note: The minimum age to sail aboard a Disney Cruise Line ship is 6 months of age on the day of sailing; however, the minimum age for Transatlantic and Panama Canal itineraries is 1 year of age on the day of sailing.





Generic things to know...

- Flights need to arrive the day prior to Sailing
- If Cruising after arriving on a domestic flight please allow at least 4 clear hours to arrive at the Port before departure and make customers aware there may be a delay
- Different Cabin types starting from Inside but always upsell
- Infants and Children still pay an Adults fare
- Normally there is Early, Late or My Time Dining
- Gratuities are compulsory and need to either be added at the time of Booking or added on after, and are approximately \$25 pp per night or \$10 per night on-board with DCL
- Excursions and Drinks packages can be added after confirmation
- Customers can log onto their booking under "Manage my Cruise"
- The disembarkation process can take anything from 1 4 hours depending on cruise line and nationality
- No cash is used on ships, customers simply link their DD/CC to their cabins

Getting to and from the Cruise Port...

- Cruises depart approximately 4pm so customers need to aim to be there just after midday (normally they will be emailed specific boarding times relating to cabin category prior to departing by the Cruise Line)
- Disembarking starts from approximately 8am and continues until 11am (however if they take their own suitcases they can depart as soon as ship is moored)
- Options to either include Cruise Transfers (be cautious of Timings) or they can take a Taxi, (Uber)
- Hiring a Car for the duration and Parking at the Cruise Port or dropping off at the nearest Alamo Office HOWEVER, there is now a one way fee if they leave the car at the nearest Alamo. We would advise customers to keep hold of car and use the pay & display
- Making the most of that last day with things such as Kennedy Space Centre, Tampa Sea Aquarium or Shopping at The Outlets (just remember they will have their luggage so Valet Parking is advised or Sea Aquarium will store for them)



Booking Cabins...

- Cabins start from Inside, to Outside, Balcony Promenade View, Balcony Outside View to a Suite
- Always try and upsell even to go from Deck 1 or 2 to Deck 4 or 5 is such a difference and yet only £20 pp more and the square feet would increase
- To an Outside or Balcony is well worth giving as an alternative option, larger more comfortable cabins with either a View of the Ocean or a Balcony and seating outside on their private Balcony
- Cruise Terminology Port or Starboard (left or right side cabins) Bow & Stern (front & back)
- If more than 1 cabin, it's imperative to check the Deck Plan so you can place the cabins near to each other and are on the same Deck
- Always either use the Deck Plans on the cruise websites or https://www.cruisecritic.co.uk/cruise-deck-plans/, www.cruisedeckplans.com
- Try and aim for mid ship as if at the very front or very back you will feel the waves
- Check the bed configuration (so as not to book Bunk Beds, Disabled cabin or Inside Bunk Beds which are above the main bed)
- If you book an Outside Cabin and above, it will always be a double bed and a double sleeper sofa





- You cannot hold Cabins with Carnival must be pay and book
- £150pp for 7 night and more £110pp for 5 and less (Carnival) and the rest subject to availability at the time of Booking
- Only book the Cruise once you have confirmed and taken payment
- Then always give the customer the booking reference to log onto "Manage My Cruise"
- They recommend booking drinks packages, excursions, gratuities and Wifi prior to boarding or can add at time of quote (subject to availability)
- If Royal Caribbean are offering All inclusive you will not need to include gratuities
- Gratuities for Carnival you do have to manually add if you want to include it
- VAT always add the VAT shown on the breakdown price page to your cost otherwise it will come to haunt you!
