

How will I be charged for parking?

When you arrive at your resort, your vehicle will be registered with security and when you check in at reception. When applicable, the appropriate overnight self-parking charge will be applied to your room each night of your stay. This will be placed on your Magic Band and when you check out of the hotel, this is when you'll pay for the charges.

If I take the Disney Magical Express to my hotel and rent a car during my stay, how will I be charged?

You'll need to let reception know that you've rented a car for X amount of days and the overnight self-parking is charged per night, per vehicle and you will pay when you check out of your hotel.

If I drive my car to the Theme Parks, will I be charged for parking fees there?

No. Because you're staying at a Disney Hotel, you need to present your Magic Band so they can scan it to confirm you're staying on site and won't have to pay extra parking fees at the Theme Parks. Blizzard Beach, Typhoon Lagoon and Disney Springs have free parking.


Stroller Changes for 2019


From the 1st May 2019, the guidelines on stroller sizes have changed. The stroller cannot be no bigger the 79cm wide and 132cm long. Stroller wagons are no longer permitted in the Theme Parks.

Smoking Policy Changes for 2019

From the 1st May 2019, no smoking is permitted within the Theme Parks, Water Parks or ESPN Wide World of Sports.

Designated smoking areas will be available outside the entrances of the Parks or in designated areas within the Resort Hotels

This is a Waiter Service Credit. Some restaurants are either 1 Credit or 2 Credits.

Signature Dining

This is 2 Waiter Service Credits. This type of dining could be character dining, fancy or dinner shows.

FAQs

The customer is staying at Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge for 21 nights but ONLY buying the 14 Day Ultimate Ticket. How many days will the customer get the dining for?

21 Nights!

The customer's park tickets will be activated from the first time they enter a Disney Theme Park and valid from 14 days from there.


The remaining 7 days where they will not be able to enter the Parks, they may use their Dining Plan in any of the Disney Hotels or in Disney Springs.


A couple is staying on site for 21 nights and they have their friends joining them for 14 nights within the same room. Which Park Tickets does the group need?

21 Day Ultimate Ticket

As Disney work off the base of rooms, the party of 4 all need to buy the exact same tickets so they can stay in the same room.

They will also receive 21 days' worth of Dine when they arrive for their 14 night holiday.





Disney Dine Credit Rules

Trade UP your table service credits

O Nowhere to trade up to.

Trade UP your quick service credits

You cannot trade your quick service credits for table service credits.

Trade UP your snack credits

2 You cannot trade up snacks credits for table or quick service credits.

Trade DOWN your table service credits

- You can use 1 table service credit for 1 quick service meal (do this by simply asking to use a table service credit when purchasing your quick service meal).
- You cannot trade table service credit for snacks

Trade DOWN your quick service credits

✓ You can use 1 quick service credit for 3 snacks (this can be done at any Disney resort or park).

Trade DOWN your snacks credits

O Nowhere to trade down to.

Can I use 1 table service credit and pay the difference at a 2 table service credit restaurant?

8 No, if a restaurant requires 2 table service credits, you either have to use 2 credits or pay out of pocket.




