

## RCL Infant Policy



### INFANT POLICY

Infants sailing on a cruise must be at least 6 months old as of the first day of the cruise and/or Cruise Tour. HOWEVER: For transatlantic, transpacific, Hawaii, select South American and other selected cruises and/or Cruise Tours, the infant must be at least 12 months old as of the first day of the cruise/Cruise Tour. For the purposes of this policy, any cruise that has 3 or more days consecutive at sea will require infants to be 12 months old on the first day of the cruise/Cruise Tour.

Infants can sail on our ships but they cannot access the pool if they are in nappies (water nappies are not allowed).

## Carnival Infant Policy



- ◇ Infant must be at least 6 months of age at time of sailing (on trans ocean/ remote itineraries it is 12 months)
- ◇ Carnival does not allow children in nappies or who are not toilet trained (this is line with the US department of Health)

## Minimum Ages for Travel

Please note: The minimum age to sail aboard a Disney Cruise Line ship is 6 months of age on the day of sailing; however, the minimum age for Transatlantic and Panama Canal itineraries is 1 year of age on the day of sailing.

## Baby On Board!

Families traveling with babies and young children have access to a host of onboard services and amenities:

Complimentary diaper disposal units, bottle warmers, bottle sterilizers, cribs and playpens are available upon request from the stateroom host/hostess.

Complimentary strollers are available at Guest Services.

Complimentary Pack-n-Play portable cribs are available. Your stateroom host or hostess can set the crib up and take it down for you each day.

Complimentary high chairs are available at all of the restaurants onboard.

Fresh pureed vegetables can be prepared at the main dining rooms and through room service, upon request.

At Castaway Cay, Disney's private island in the Bahamas, complimentary wagons are available to facilitate navigating the island's sandy beaches.

Essential baby supplies are available for purchase at the onboard merchandise shops, including diapers, training pants, rash cream, infant formula (ready to feed), bottles, pacifiers, baby food, baby shampoo, baby lotion and baby powder.

All complimentary services and amenities are offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please note: Guests may bring baby food and formula onboard the ship as carry-on items as long as they are pre-packaged, unopened and do not require any food preparation from the kitchen .

## Nurseries

Disney Cruise Line infant care centers provide parents both peace of mind and an opportunity for Mom and Dad to relax and enjoy a little exclusive time together.

Our nurseries are for children ages 6 months to 3 years (or ages 1 to 3 years for Transatlantic, and Panama Canal itineraries) and offer extended hours to accommodate the ships' many activities.

## Toddler Play Areas
